This project involves researching a discovery/development of modern healthcare history. You will work in groups of 2 to create a digital or physical modern history display that contains exhibits pertinent to your topic. The display can be in the form of a slideshow, video or other digital format that would be appropriate (please get approval from me for your display format before constructing or a physical presentation board. (4th period--7 groups of 2, 5th period--6 groups of 2)

Topics for Your Displays

- 1. History and development of medical insurance plans
- 2. Discovery of properties of blood and roles it plays in the body
- 3. The structure of DNA and research in gene therapy
- 4. Surgical and diagnostic procedures and tools of modern medicine
- 5. Role of infection control in more positive outcomes and decreased mortality rate
- 6. Epidemics in modern healthcare history (1900-present)
- 7. Pharmaceutical discoveries of modern history and their effect on health
- 8. History of vaccine development and their effect on disease rates
- 9. History and advancement in organ transplant, both human & artificial
- 10. Stem cells--research, discoveries, controversies & potential uses
- 11. Legalization of euthansia--history, geographic locations and current laws
- 12. Bioterrorism--its use, occurrences and potentials

Requirements

- 1. Your display should include the items listed below:
 - Definition or description of your development/discovery
 - People who contributed to or were involved in the development/discovery
 - Timeline of the development/discovery
 - Effect on overall health/morbidity/mortality of the world
 - Potential of further positive development/uses of your development/discovery
- 2. Your museum display must utilize at least four items/"exhibits" listed below to accomplish the project requirements listed on # 1. Below are examples of what would qualify:
 - Pictures
 - Illustrations
 - Symbols
 - Timelines
 - Charts
 - Graphs
 - Tables
 - Maps
 - Diary accounts of participants
 - Important quotes

- Each "exhibit" in your display must have an explanation of the "exhibit" that introduces viewers to it. The explanation should include:
 - 1) A title for the "exhibit"
 - 2) The people or person involved, if applicable

3) An explanation of why the "exhibit" played a role or was important in your development/ discovery

- 4) The significance of the discovery or innovation both then and now
- 3. Each group member is required to brainstorm ideas, do research and contribute information for each exhibit, create the design of the display, and help with the construction and creation of the museum display.
 - Below the grading rubric is where you should log which group member did what in the preparation, planning, researching and constructing of your display (this is part of your grade).
- 4. Your group will present your Modern History of Healthcare Museum Display to the class Each presentation should last **4-5 minutes**.
